



Sermon Notes February 7, 2021

Our Passover

(Part 2)

TEXT: Romans 15:4 , 1 Corinthians 5:6-8

Today we have a Passover lamb ourselves.

- Christ is our Passover.

7 ways that Jesus is our Passover.

1. They were both lambs.

Exodus 12:5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old.

Jesus is called a Lamb by John the baptizer.

Behold the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world

John 1: 29 The next day he *saw Jesus coming to him and *said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

2. They were both males

Exodus 12:5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old.

Jesus was a son

Matthew 1:23 "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."

3. They were both without blemish.

Exodus 12:5 Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old.

Jesus was without Blemish I Peter 1:18-19

1 Peter 1: 18-19 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, 19 but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

4. They both died between the evenings. Vrs 6

Exodus 12:6 and ye shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month; and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it at even. (The jews recognized two evenings 12 noon when the sun moved to the setting position and 6 o'clock in the evening. Between the two evenings would have been 3:00)

Jesus died between the two evenings.

Mark 15: 34-37 At the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, "ELOI, ELOI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" which is translated, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?" 35 When some of the bystanders heard it, they began saying, "Behold, He is calling for Elijah." 36 Someone ran and filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on a reed, and gave Him a drink, saying, "Let us see whether

Elijah will come to take Him down." 37 And Jesus uttered a loud cry, and breathed His last.

5. They were both suspended between heaven and earth. Vrs. 8,9

Exodus 12:8-9 And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; with bitter herbs they shall eat it. 9 Eat not of it raw, nor boiled at all with water, but roast with fire; its head with its legs and with the inwards thereof.

Jesus was hung on a cross

Acts 5: 30 "The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you had put to death by hanging Him on a cross.

6. They both had no bones broken.

Exodus 12:46 In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not carry forth ought of the flesh abroad out of the house; neither shall ye break a bone thereof.

Jesus had no bones broken.

John 19:31-36 Then the Jews, because it was the day of preparation, so that the bodies would not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day), asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away. 32 So the soldiers came, and broke the legs of the first man and of the other who was crucified with Him; 33 but coming to Jesus, when they saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs. 34 But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out. 35 And he who has seen has testified, and his testimony is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you also may believe. 36 For these things came to pass to fulfill the Scripture, "NOT A BONE OF HIM SHALL BE BROKEN."

7. They both had their blood shed

Exodus 12:21-22 Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel and said to them, "Go and take for yourselves lambs according to your families, and slay the Passover lamb. 22 "You shall take a bunch of hyssop and dip it in the blood which is in the basin, and apply some of the blood that is in the basin to the lintel and the two doorposts; and none of you shall go outside the door of his house until morning.

Jesus blood was shed on the cross

John 19:34 But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

It was on that cross our Passover Christ was crucified!!
